If the user experiences any issues with the streaming of the scan then please follow these steps.

Recommendation:

We advise the end users to use preferably Chrome Browser since Fire Fox and Safari Support only front Camera.

Purpose:


This document is meant to help the Admin and Volunteer to configure the Camera if QR scanning shows error while performing Check-In Scanning. The Scanning can be performed multiple devices while Chrome, Fire Fox and Safari Browser are supported.

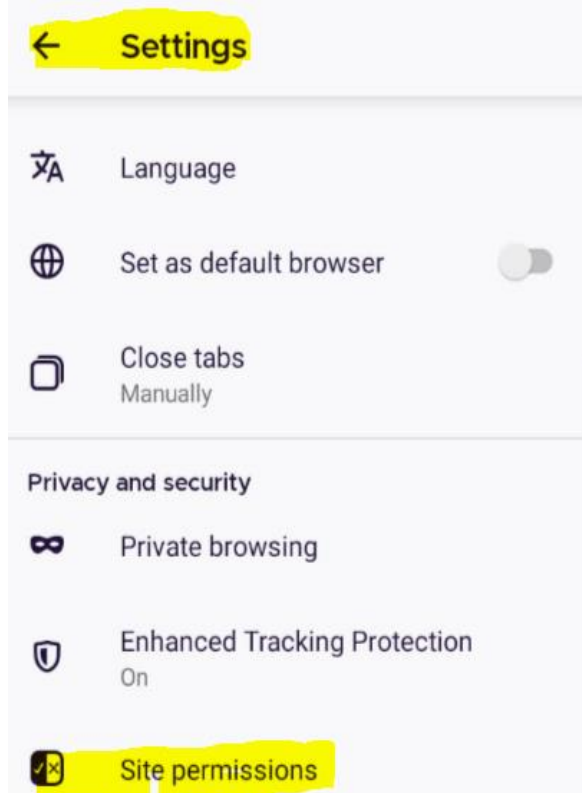


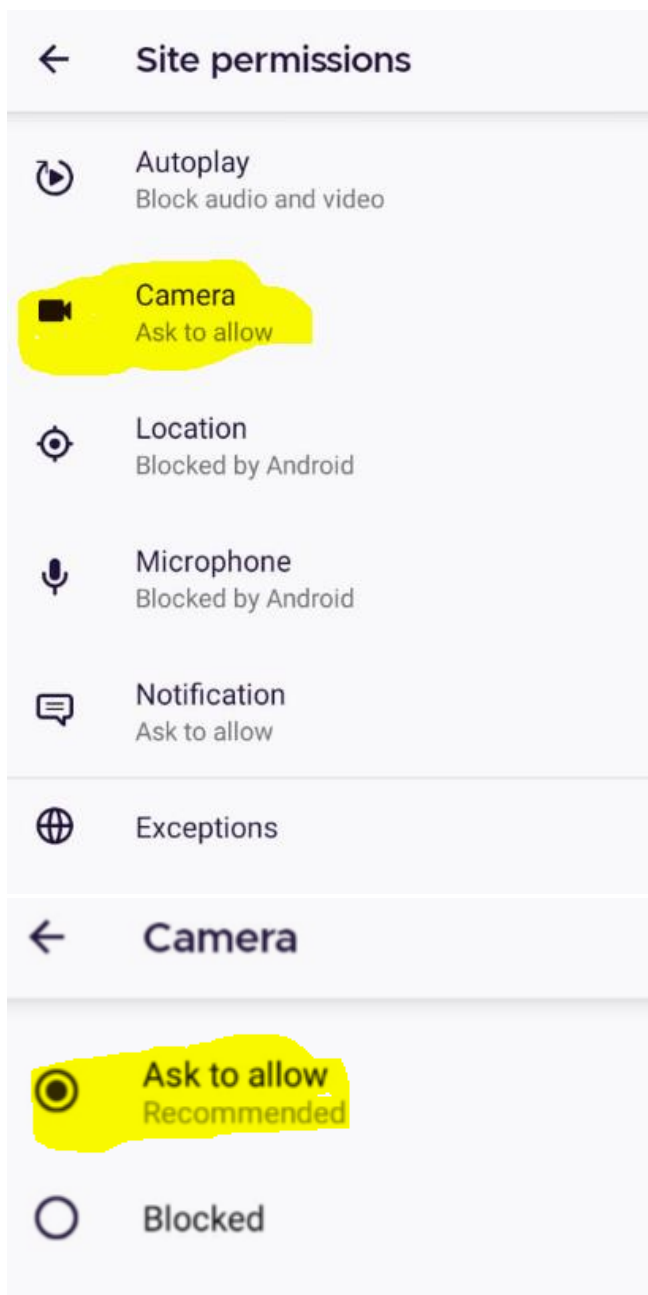
