Users will automatically get the access to many of the devices by allowing the camera option.

If the user experiences any issues with the streaming of the scan then please follow these steps.

Recommendation:

**We advise the end users to use preferably Chrome Browser since Fire Fox and Safari Support only front Camera.**

Purpose:

This document is meant to help the Admin and Volunteer to configure the Camera if QR scanning shows error while performing Check-In Scanning. The Scanning can be performed multiple devices while Chrome, Fire Fox and Safari Browser are supported.

Chrome Browser:

**Steps - Go to Setting of Browsers-Privacy and Security- Site Settings- Camera Setting- Remove the url from Block List and Allow the Camera usage to <https://admin.smartjamaat.com> site.**







Firefox Browser:


